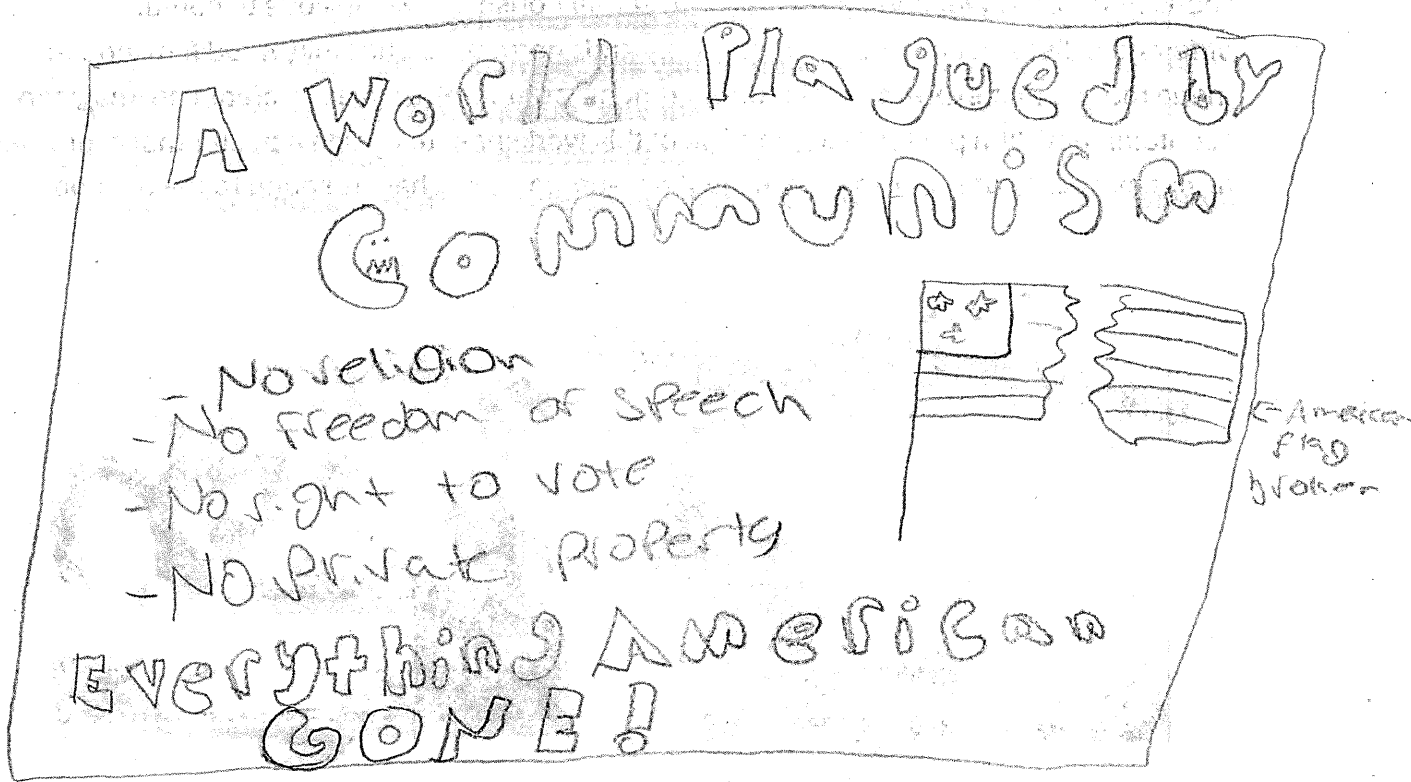


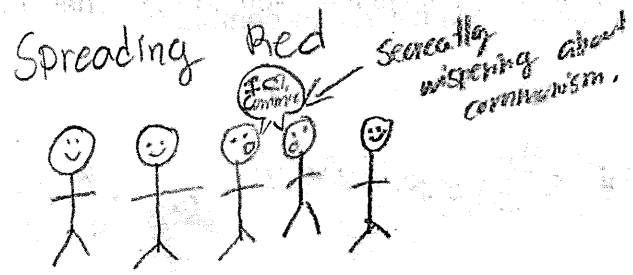
Design a "containment culture" film poster from the 1950s era of Cold War conformity and consensus liberalism:

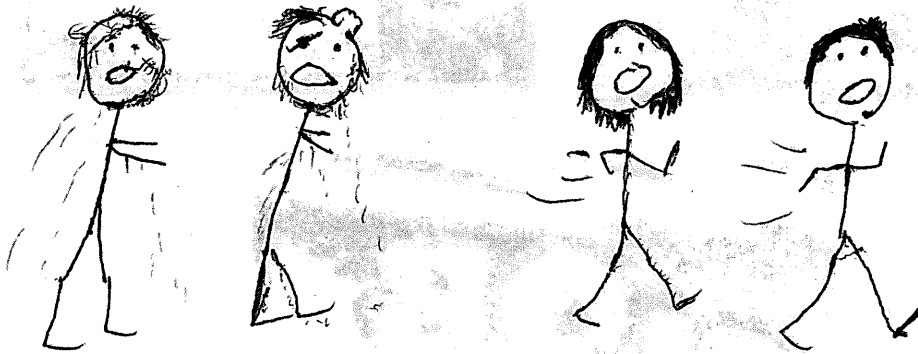

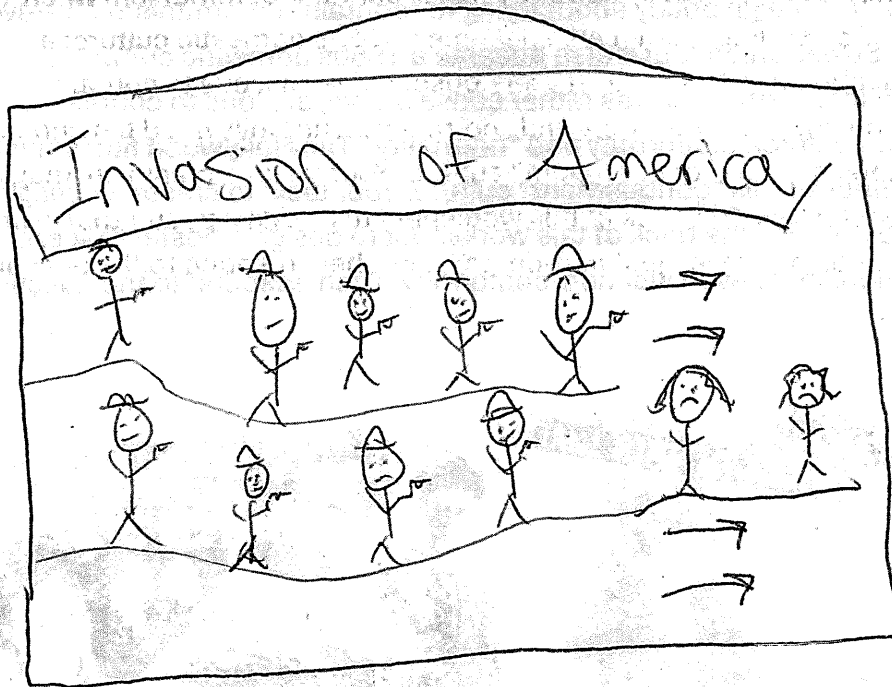
## The red plague

This poster is for a movie about "the red plague" which is a zombie outbreak/virus spreading.

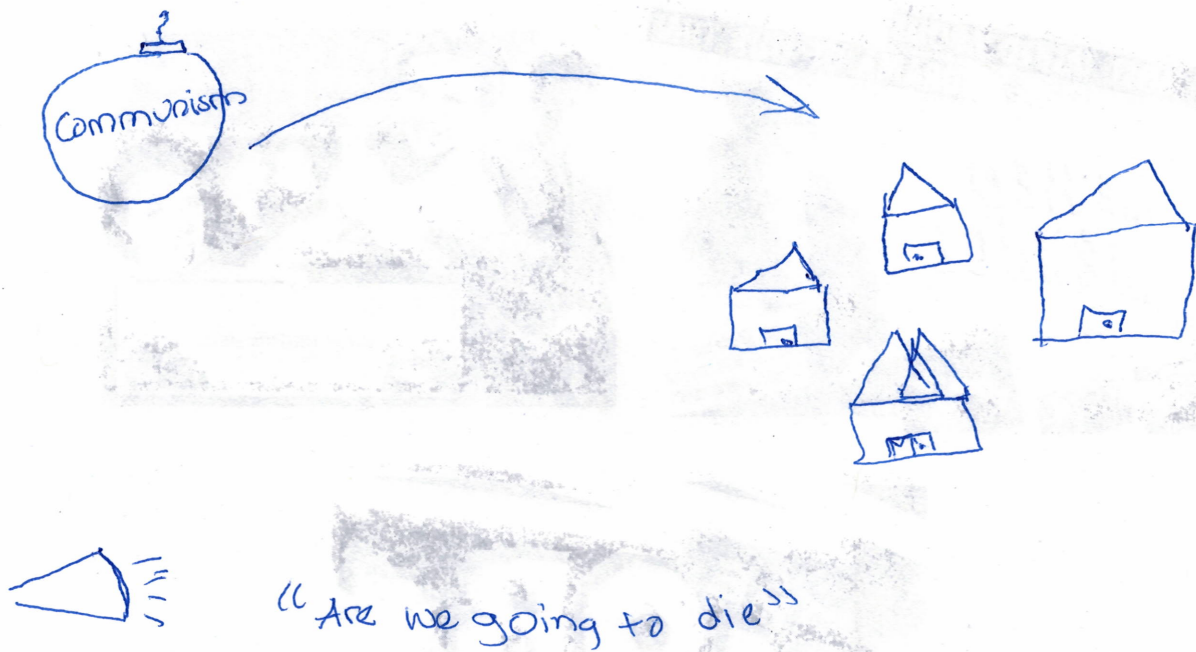

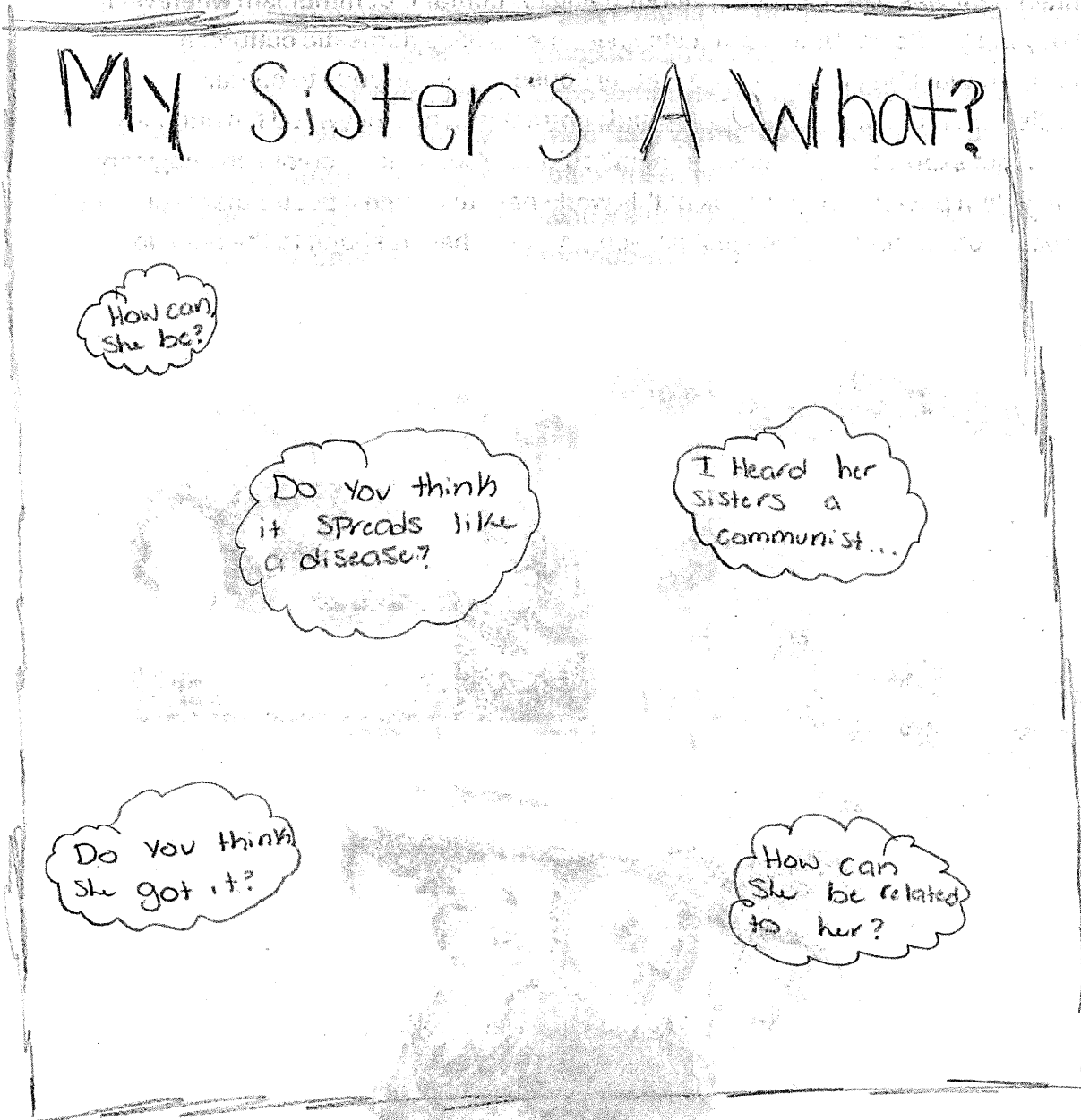

My poster could've appeared during the 1950's because it displays the fear of communism. It shows how people thought it was dangerous.

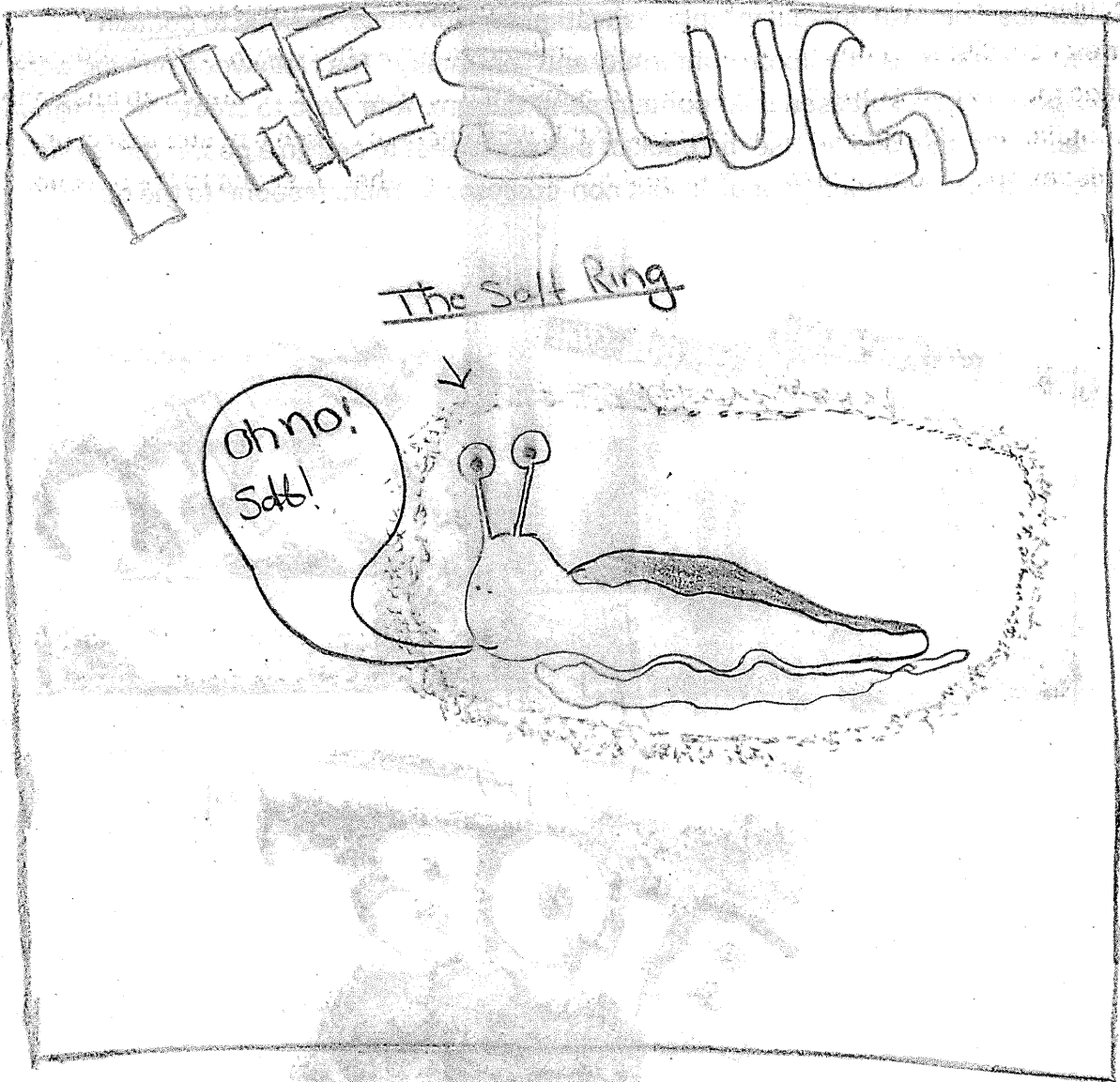

This poster shows a person stuck in jail/horror and is contained from conformity. They are in fear and scared on the future.

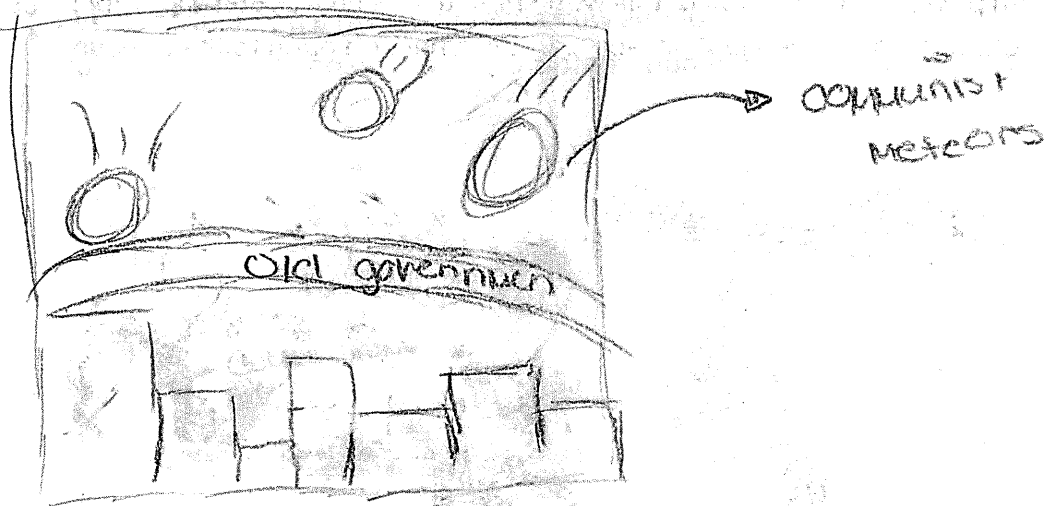

Slugs hate salt so if there is a ring of salt around a slug they can't escape. No escape = Containment

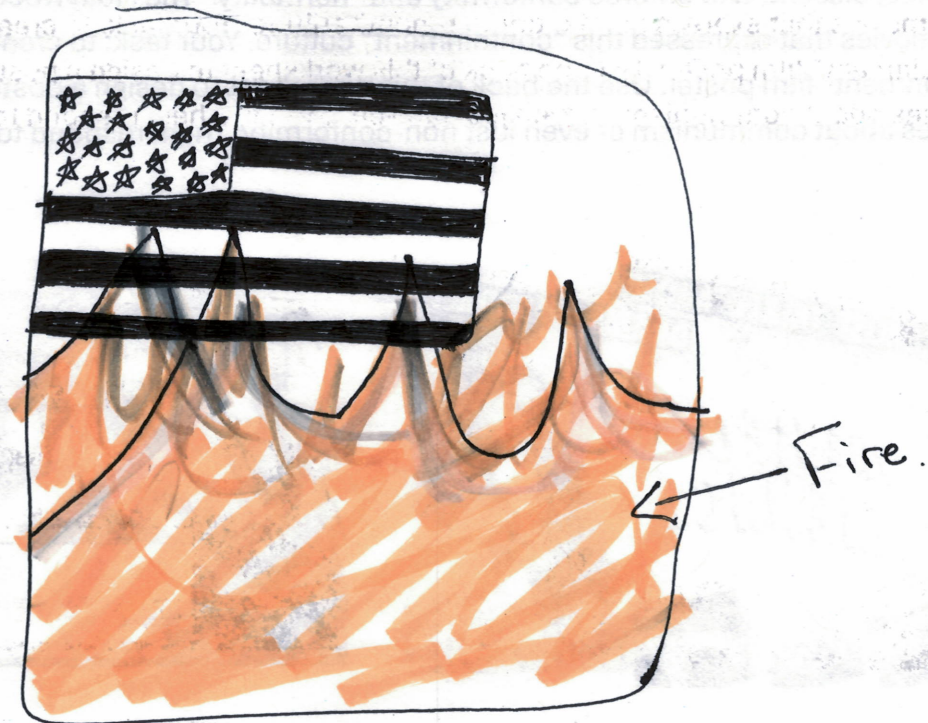

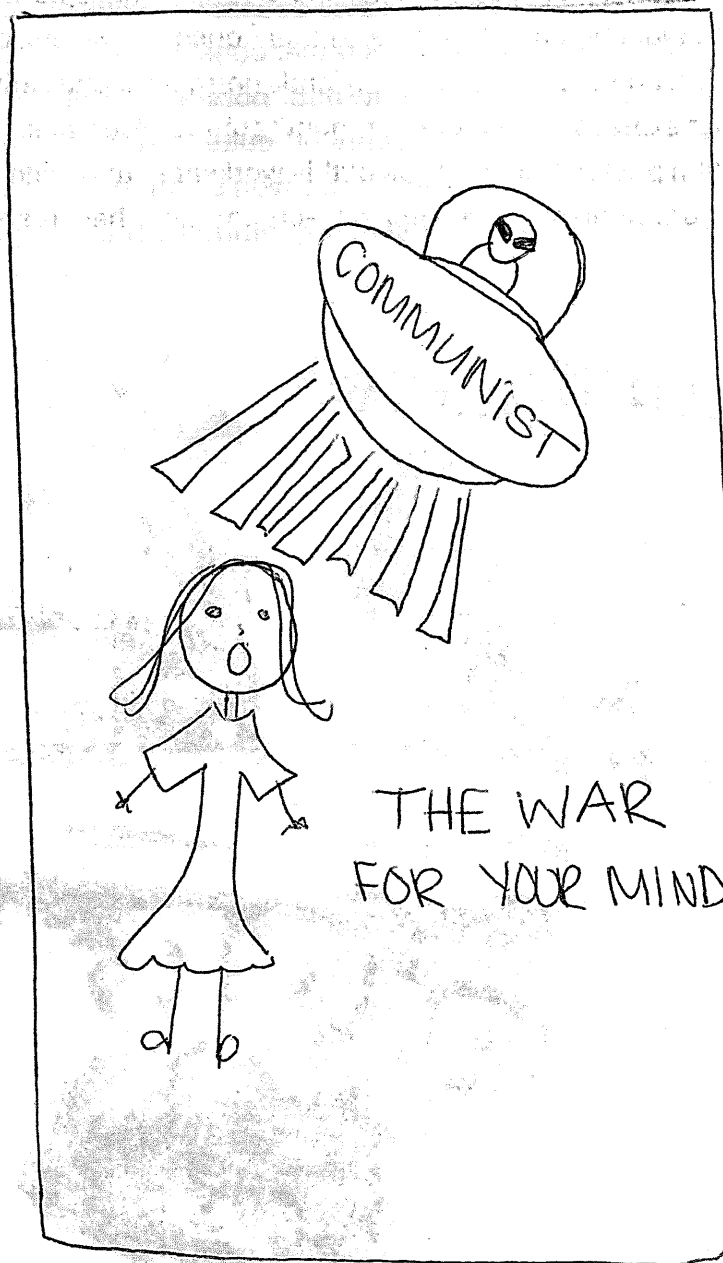
